THINGS TO CONSIDER

Showcases are designed to display your refrigerated products at 38-41°F (4-5°C). Showcases are designed to perform in environments of maximum 75°F (23°C) and 55% relative humidity.

NOTE: FOR YOUR SHOWCASE TO FUNCTION AT PEAK EFFICIENCY YOU WILL NEED PROPER CLIMATE CONTROL AND AIR CIRCULATION

You need to consider the following when selecting a showcase and placing it in your store environment:

Consider nearby doorways and vestibules

Consider nearby windows

Consider nearby vent sources, hoods, cooking equipment and fans

Ensure your display is level and plumb



A location near a doorway will negatively affect the airflow and holding temperature of both open and closed showcases.



Direct sunlight will negatively affect the holding temperature of both open and closed showcases.



HVAC ceiling vents, exhaust hoods, cooking equipment (steam heat) and ceiling fans will negatively affect the airflow of open showcases and will create condensation on the showcases if not properly managed.



Ensure your showcase is plumb and level to allow for proper drainage of condensation water.

Please note: These are critical points to ensure the best results for your equipment and efficient space – and the best return on your investment!



Regular Maintenance and Cleaning

Your showcase will work at its peak performance with regular maintenance. Refer to the Owner's Manual for maintenance and cleaning instructions.

Leave appropriate space behind display

Clean your condenser grill and pre-filter

ONLY PRE-CHILLED product in case

Condensation on closed and open cases



A 6" space is required behind any showcase that is against a wall or has a rear obstruction to allow for proper air flow around your showcase.



Use the included brush to regularly wipe away dust. Too much dust will not allow the refrigeration to work properly and could result in **expensive** damage.

Refrigerated displays are designed to KEEP COLD PRODUCT COLD – they are not designed to bring warm products down to a cold temperature. For food safety it is always imperative that warm product be properly chilled (using a blast chiller or cold room) prior to storing in the refrigerated display case.



Self-contained cases have compressors, motors and fans and these will make noise. Keeping your showcase serviced and clean will help keep the noise level under control, improve lifespan, and maintain efficiency.




Condensation is caused by warm, moist air coming into contact with cool surfaces. If the case environment is not maintained below 75°F/23°C and 55% relative humidity, condensation may occur.







FLORAL STEPS OUTSIDE CORNER - 3 STEP
